



2012 KING RICHARD'S RESERVE

The 2012 growing season in the Russian River was long and mildly warm in contrast to the previous cooler vintages of 2011 and 2010. These ideal growing conditions produced wines with excellent balance and natural acidity that will age well for many years.

The 2012 King Richard's Reserve was produced from four different sites throughout the Russian River and three different clones, all contributing to the layers of this complex wine. Aromas of crushed raspberries and cherries combined with perfume and dried flowers continually open up from the glass. Laser focus with pure Pinot Noir varietal characters and an abundance of vibrant fruit and spice flavors combine with well-integrated oak on the palate. A creamy and lush mid-palate is followed by a persistent finish of fruit, supple tannins and dried spices.
