PINOT NOIR

The 2013 growing season began early and provided ample sunshine plus consistently warm days that allowed for optimum fruit ripening. This bottling of King Richard's Reserve shows an ever-changing, complex nose of dried spices reminiscent of Russian River Pinot, backed by notes of dark fruits, tobacco, lavender and minerality. The seamless palate shows plenty of weight and supple tannins, supporting flavors of blackberry and raspberry. Well-integrated oak and dark fruits linger on the long finish.
